DAILY ITINERARY:

April 16 – Check in at the host campground in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, followed by a welcome dinner and orientation with the Tour Directors.

April 17 – The day begins with a Carolina Safari jeep tour followed by a visit to Broadway at the Beach and lunch on your own. Visit Ripley's Aquarium after lunch. This evening, you will enjoy a Murder Mystery Dinner Theatre, maybe even as a participant!

April 18 – Visit Brookgreen Gardens and enjoy lunch followed by a miniature golf tournament. Dinner at Yamato's Japanese Steakhouse, and then a performance of Le Grand Cirque at the Palace Theatre.



April 19 - Depart Myrtle Beach for Charleston. Cruise around Charleston Harbor with a stop at Fort Sumter. Dinner at Poogans Porch Restaurant, followed by a visit with a local storyteller, who will regale you with some great low country tales.

April 20 – Enjoy a historical tour of Charleston followed by free time at the Old City market. This afternoon, visit Boone Hall, one of America's oldest working plantations.

April 21 – Depart for Wadmalaw Island and tour of the Charleston Tea Plantation, the only tea plantation in the country and the producer of Bigelow Tea. Then we visit Patriot's Point Naval and Maritime Museum, home of the *USS Yorktown*, followed by a dinner cruise aboard the *Spirit of Carolina* yacht. Enjoy spectacular views of Charleston Harbor along with your dinner.



April 22 – Head for Savannah, Georgia. This evening features dinner and an exclusive performance by the Puppet People.

April 23 - We have an informative tour of historic Savannah, which includes a visit to the historic Owens-Thomas House. Free time for shopping and lunch on your own on River Street. After lunch, enjoy a carriage ride through downtown Savannah.



April 24 – Depart for a Low Country Tour that includes Tybee Island, Fort Pulaski, and a stop at Byrd Cookie Company, followed by lunch aboard the Savannah Riverboat. Dine tonight at Paula Deen's The Lady and Sons Restaurant, followed by a show at the historic Savannah Theatre.
