### DISABLED SERVICES

- Handicapped auto parking, aircraft parking/camping, restrooms, showers and tram services are available.
- One-seat personal electric convenience vehicles, specifically designed for the handicapped, are allowed on the convention site. Automobiles, golf carts, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles and all-terrain vehicles are not recognized as authorized vehicles for the handicapped.
