DAILY ITINERARY:

Day 1 - Tonight enjoy our traditional welcome dinner. After dinner, your Tour Directors will conduct a short orientation and answer any questions you may have.

Day 2 - This morning is free for you to enjoy the area. We will have lunch at the Fish House Grill and take a half-day narrated tour of Acadia National Park, one of the coast's most beautiful areas.

Day 3 - Today we are off to Saint John, New Brunswick. The scenery is just what you expect it to be, so take your time and enjoy! The ferry will take you from Saint John to Harding's Point, our home for the next two nights.

Day 4 - An all-day tour of Saint John is on tap today. First we will take a guided tour of the city; shop in Market Square, stop for lunch, and then take a fascinating afternoon tour of the "Reversing Falls."

Day 5 - We are headed to Prince Edward Island today. After more breathtaking scenery along the way, you will enjoy a spectacular drive across the Northumberland Strait that separates New Brunswick from Prince Edward Island.

Day 6 - Chartered motorcoaches will take us on a "North Shore" tour of the island which includes numerous stops and admission to several attractions. Lunch is included at the Fisherman's Wharf.

Day 7 - You are on your own today so you will have time to explore this quaint, historic, and scenic island at your leisure. In the evening, we will start with a wonderful dinner followed by reserved seats for the *Anne of Green Gables* musical at the Confederation Center of the Arts.

Day 8 - Back across the Northumberland Strait to nearby Truro, Nova Scotia, just north of Halifax. It is a short drive so take your time and enjoy the scenery.

Day 9 - Chartered motorcoaches will pick us up this morning for a tour of Halifax. We will see Peggy's Cove, the changing of the guard (weather permitting), and the waterfront. Lunch will be served in a private room reserved just for the Good Sam Club at the Citadel Inn.



Day 10 - Check with your Tour Directors for some suggestions of what to see in the area. They have many ideas on how best to spend your day.

Day 11 - Delightful drive today to Cape Breton Island, the last stop on this tour of Nova Scotia.

Day 12 - The Cabot Trail is one of the most breathtaking drives in North America. It winds along the edge of Cape Breton Highland National Park. A guided motorcoach bus tour includes several sightseeing stops and dinner at The Harbour Restaurant.

Day 13 - Musket firing and the sound of drums echo across the Fortress of Louisbourg, circa 1744. We will take a guided tour of the fortress and then enjoy an 18th century lunch at the Hotel de la Marine, where townspeople, sailors and soldiers came to eat, drink and relax. The day will end with our traditional farewell dinner.

Day 14 - Your Tour Directors will have hot coffee and doughnuts ready before you depart.
