## EASTERN CANADA CARAVENTURE

We invite you to explore the eastern provinces on the Good Sam Club's 2010 Eastern Canada Caraventure. This 1,700 mile trip has been carefully designed to show you the historic and scenic highlights of this culturally diverse area.

The Caraventure begins in Ottawa and continues through Quebec, including Montreal and the provincial capital Quebec City, where french is the official language. Overlooking the St. Lawrence River, Quebec is so rich in history that UNESCO proclaimed Old Quebec a "World Heritage Treasure," the only city in North America designated as such. An all-day motorcoach tour with an English-speaking guide will visit the Plains of Abraham, the Basilica of Ste. Anne-de-Beaupre, Saint Anne Falls and Canyon.



Our itinerary follows the St. Lawrence River around the picturesque Gaspé Peninsula with stops in Rimouski, Cap Chat, and Percé. In Percé, we will enjoy a morning tour of the lovely seaside community and lunch at a local restaurant followed by a boat tour to Bonaventure Island and Percé Rock.

In New Brunswick, we will stop in Nigadoo for a night's rest. Then it is on to Shediac for a two-night stay, allowing time to visit Acadian Historical Village. While in Shediac, take time to visit the Hopewell Cape "Flower Pot Rocks" carved by the tides, ice and rain. We will drive the new Northumberland Strait Bridge for 12.9 km (approximately eight miles) to Prince Edward Island for a three-night stay. While on the island, we will have a bus tour, dinner, and theater tickets to *Anne of Green Gables*.

Nova Scotia - land of the sea! We start our Nova Scotia experience with a guided bus tour of Halifax and Peggy's Cove including lunch at the Citadel Inn. The next stop is Cape Breton Island where you will enjoy a guided bus tour of the Cabot Trail, described as the most spectacular drive in North America, including lunch. A tour of the Fortress of Louisbourg will include lunch, and later that evening we will share a farewell dinner with our newfound friends.
